

Coastal Bend Crime Stoppers Law Enforcement Scholarship \$500.00

Bee County Goliad County Live Oak County

Criteria for eligibility:

- 1. Must be May graduate of a high school in Bee, Goliad or Live Oak counties.
- 2. Completed application and resume submitted to appropriate high school counselor by specified deadline.
- 3. Must attend a junior/community college or 4-year college/university upon graduation majoring in law enforcement/criminal justice.
- 4. G.P.A. sufficient to gain admittance to an institution listed in No. 3 above.
- 5. In need of financial assistance. Must explain need.
- 6. To pursue a degree in the field of criminal justice.

Procedures – Student:

- 1. Submit completed, typed application with essay.
- 2. Submit current transcript showing class rank and GPA.
- 3. Submit completed, typed resume. Resumes shall include:
 - (1) a detailed description of services rendered at school and in community and
 - (2) explanation as to why applicant is applying for this scholarship.
- 4. Submit application, essay, transcript and resume by specified time.

Procedures for award:

- 1. Counselors from each high school are to submit completed applications and resumes to Coastal Bend Crime Stoppers.
- 2. The Coastal Bend Crimes Stoppers directors shall make the final selection of the recipient of the scholarship.
- 3. In the event there are no qualifying applicants for the scholarship, the scholarship will not be given out.

Payment of Scholarship:

- 1. One half of the scholarship will be awarded in the fall and one half will be awarded in the spring.
- 2. Student must show proof of enrollment (bill from registrar and schedule of classes) prior to receiving each semester's payment.
