Wanted for Attempted Robbery:

Indianapolis, IN: The Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department is asking for the public's help in identifying a man wanted for Attempted Robbery. On January 7, 2013, the man entered the CVS Pharmacy at 7935 East Brookville Road, in Indianapolis, IN, handed a note to the pharmacy tech, said he had a gun and not to talk to anyone. The note was given to the pharmacist and the pharmacist told the suspect he needed a prescription. The suspect then left the business. This is believed to be the same suspect that robbed the CVS Pharmacy at 8405 East Southeastern Avenue a half hour later.

The suspect is described as a white male, in his 20's, 5-feet-8-inches tall, wearing a black or dark colored New York Yankees baseball cap, brown hooded Carhart coat, white t-shirt, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes with black trim.
