**GOLDEN 1 OFFERS \$10,000 REWARD
FOR INFORMATION THAT LEADS TO THE ARREST
OF ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECT**

SAN LUIS OBISPO, Calif., July 6, 2012—The Golden 1 Credit Union is offering a \$10,000 reward for information that leads to the arrest and prosecution of the man who robbed a Golden 1 branch in San Luis Obispo, Calif., on May 3, 2012.

The robbery occurred at approximately 3:15 p.m. at the Golden 1 branch located at 852 E. Foothill Boulevard in San Luis Obispo. The suspect exited the bank and was last seen running northbound from the credit union, toward Boysen Avenue.

The suspect is described as an African American or dark Hispanic male approximately 5'9" tall, with a stocky build. He was described as wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt, jeans, blue tennis shoes, and a dark shirt or bandana partially covering his face. One witness observed a tattoo on his left hand with the letters "LA."
